An ordinance regulating the paving of sidewalks in the Borough of New Alexandria

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of New Alexandria and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1

That each and every owner of property or properties on Main Street in said Borough in front of which a good and sufficient pavement is not now laid, shall within three months from the passage of this ordinance lay or cause to be laid a hard brick or smooth stone pavement on the sidewalk in front of his or her respective premises abutting of said Main Street.

Section 2

That in case of the failure of any of said property holders to comply with any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance the Borough Council shall lay or cause to be laid all such required pavements as abutting lot owners have failed to lay and collect from said abutting lot owners the full cost of said pavements together with 20% additional.

Section 3

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
